

## FROM THE DESK OF SR KAREN...

"O God... grant that we may be so fashioned by your grace as to become a dwelling pleasing to you." Opening Prayer

How can that happen? We need to dwell near a stream of life-giving water, as we hear in the first reading from Jeremiah and the Psalm. Unlike trees or plants that cannot move, we have the freedom to be in places where we can reach this life-giving water. We gather each week in this holy place where the waters of life flow. These waters come from one another, from God's word in Scripture, and in the celebration of the liturgy, which entails the

joining of our voices with the choir in song, letting the words flow out for all ears to hear and be refreshed. All of us have a part to play in this gathering: the Presider, the Deacon, Eucharistic Ministers, Choir, Servers, Readers, Ushers. All in attendance offer our responses and sing our parts. The waters of life flow through the community and back to each of us. As this happens, the Spirit's presence is manifested, hearts are touched and moved, and healing happens. God's presence lives in the midst of us. We are the dwelling place of God.

May God fill our hearts with an eagerness to enter into the joy and enthusiasm of being a dwelling place for Spirit each time we come to Liturgy and then take that living water from here to all we meet.



## Pilgrimage to France


August 17-29, 2025

## Jubilee 2025: Pilgrims of Hope

2025 is the Jubilee Holy Year, the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord, an "event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church." The concept of "Jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation, pilgrimage, and coming home. Pope Francis has designated the 2025 Holy Year as a time to renew ourselves as "Pilgrims of Hope."
